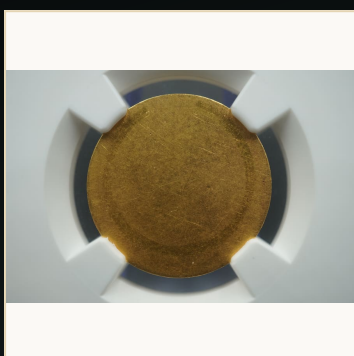

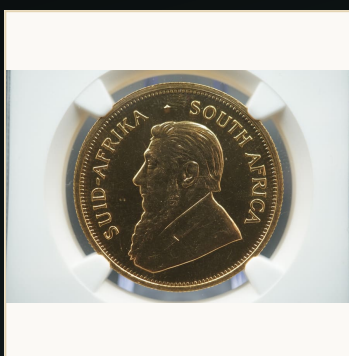

A certified Mint State example of the 1933 South African silver 2 Shillings, struck during the reign of King George V and graded MS61 by NGC. This issue is a better early Union silver date, with Hern listing catalogue values of R20,000 in UNC and R12,500 in EF.

The coin forms part of the 1931-1936 SUID-AFRIKA type, featuring the crowned portrait of King George V on the obverse and the ornate quartered shield reverse. With only 11 coins recorded in higher grades at NGC, this example offers strong appeal to collectors of early Union silver, King George V coinage, and certified South African type coins.

A certified Mint State example of the 1935 South African silver 2 Shillings, struck during the reign of King George V and graded MS62 by NGC. This issue is a better early Union silver date, with Hern listing catalogue values of R18,000 in UNC and R10,000 in EF.

The coin forms part of the 1931-1936 SUID-AFRIKA type, featuring the crowned portrait of King George V on the obverse and the ornate quartered shield reverse. With only 9 coins recorded in higher grades at NGC, this example offers strong appeal to collectors of early Union silver, King George V coinage, and certified South African type coins.

A high-grade Proof example of the 1959 South African gold 1/2 Pound, struck during the reign of Queen Elizabeth II and graded PF66 by NGC. This pre-decimal gold issue forms part of the final Union-era gold pound series before South Africa's transition to decimal currency in 1961.

The obverse features Mary Gillick's young laureate portrait of Queen Elizabeth II, while the reverse carries Coert L. Steynberg's springbok design, a distinctly South African motif later strongly associated with the Krugerrand series.

In PF66, this example offers strong appeal to collectors of South African gold, Queen Elizabeth II pre-decimal coinage, and certified Union Proof issues. A Proof example of the 1923 South African gold 1/2 Sovereign, struck during the reign of King George V and graded PF64 by NGC. This issue belongs to South Africa's first gold sovereign series struck with the SA mint mark at Pretoria, following the establishment of Union coinage.

The obverse features the bare head portrait of King George V, while the reverse retains the classic St George and the dragon design used on British sovereign coinage. As an early Pretoria Mint gold Proof issue, this example offers strong appeal to collectors of South African gold, King George V coinage, sovereign issues, and certified Union Proof coins.

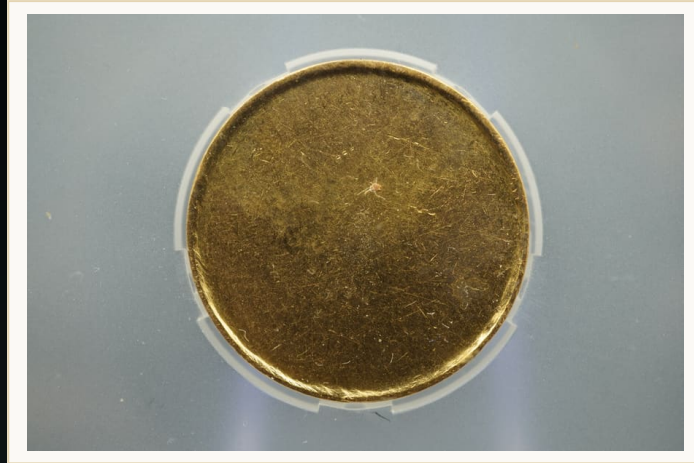
A certified ND(1900) ZAR Kaalpenny with Rim, catalogued by Hern as Z63. This unusual Boer War emergency issue was produced from a blank penny planchet and is associated with the final wartime period of the Zuid-Afrikaansche Republiek, when normal minting operations were disrupted.

The term "Kaalpenny" refers to its blank, unstamped appearance, with this example being the rimmed penny variety. As a specialist ZAR necessity issue authenticated by NGC, this piece offers strong appeal to collectors of South African Republic coinage, Anglo-Boer War material, emergency coinage, and advanced ZAR varieties.

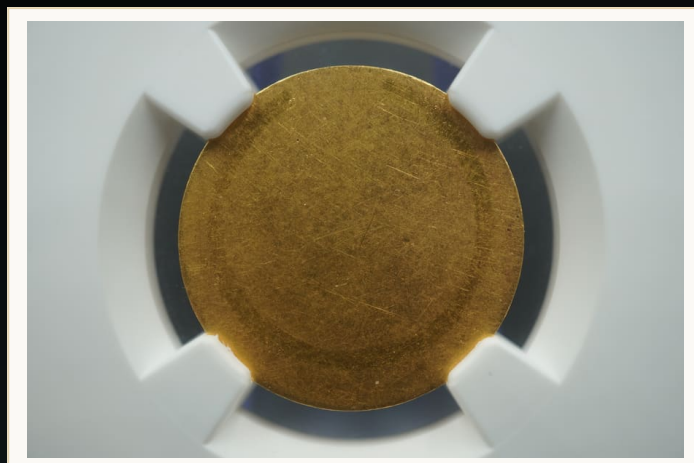
AUCTIONEER'S OPINION

A certified ND(1900) ZAR Gold Kaalpond with Rim, catalogued by Hern as Z56. This unusual Boer War emergency issue consists of a blank gold pond planchet that was prepared for striking but left without the normal Paul Kruger and ZAR arms designs.

The Kaalponds are associated with the disruption of the Pretoria Mint during the Second Anglo-Boer War, when ZAR gold and silver were moved before British forces occupied Pretoria in June 1900. As a gold ZAR blank pond with rim, certified by SANGS, this piece offers strong appeal to collectors of South African Republic gold, Anglo-Boer War emergency coinage, and advanced ZAR specialist material.

A certified ND(1900) ZAR Gold Kaalpond Without Rim, catalogued by Hern as Z55. This unusual Boer War emergency issue consists of a blank gold pond planchet prepared for striking but left without the normal Paul Kruger and ZAR arms designs.

The Kaalponds are associated with the disruption of the Pretoria Mint during the Second Anglo-Boer War, when ZAR gold and silver were moved before British forces occupied Pretoria in June 1900. As a rimless gold ZAR blank pond authenticated by NGC, this piece offers strong appeal to collectors of South African Republic gold, Anglo-Boer War emergency coinage, and advanced ZAR specialist material.

A certified Mint State example of the 1900 ZAR Gold Pond, struck during the final year of regular South African Republic gold coinage. This issue was produced during the Second Anglo-Boer War, shortly before the occupation of Pretoria and the disruption of normal ZAR minting operations.

The obverse features the portrait of President Paul Kruger, while the reverse carries the arms of the Zuid-Afrikaansche Republiek with the 1 POND denomination and the national motto "Eendragt Maakt Magt". As a regular struck 1900 Pond in MS63, this piece offers strong appeal to collectors of ZAR gold, Paul Kruger coinage, Anglo-Boer War-era issues, and certified pre-Union South African gold.

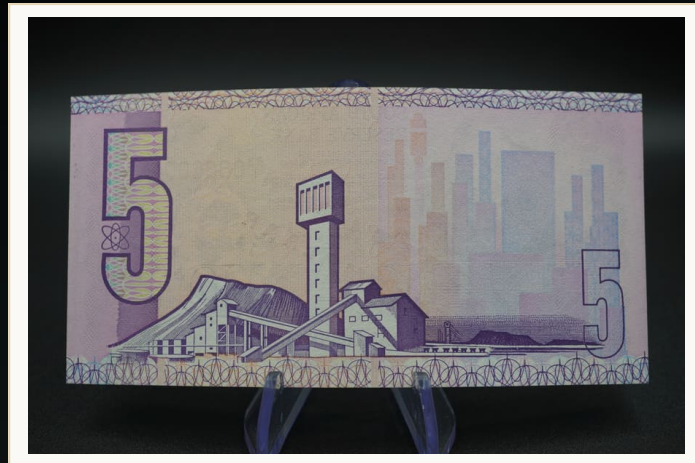

AUCTIONEER'S OPINION

A South African Reserve Bank specimen One Rand banknote bearing the T.W. de Jongh signature and serial number B/1 000000. This Afrikaans-English type belongs to the smaller-format One Rand issue introduced during the 1970s, with the issued P-116a type carrying the B/1 to B/339 prefix range and a springbok watermark.

The note forms part of South Africa's decimal banknote series, with the One Rand denomination retaining the familiar portrait and rams reverse design used across several early Republic issues. As a specimen example with all-zero serial numbering, it offers appeal to collectors of South African paper money, Reserve Bank specimens, decimal transition-era notes, and specialist T.W. de Jongh signature varieties.

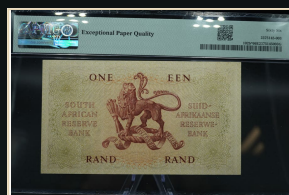

A South African Reserve Bank Specimen Five Rand banknote bearing the G.P.C. de Kock signature and all-zero specimen serial number B3/1 000000. This type forms part of the later small-size Five Rand series issued from 1978 onwards, with the English-Afrikaans format placing the English text before the Afrikaans text.

The issued note features the traditional portrait at left, a multicoloured purple design, and a mining scene on the reverse, reflecting South Africa's industrial and mining economy. As an ungraded specimen example, it offers appeal to collectors of South African paper money, Reserve Bank specimens, decimal banknotes, and G.P.C. de Kock signature varieties.

A superb Gem Uncirculated example of the early South African Replacement One Rand banknote, bearing the G. Rissik signature and certified by PMG as 66 Gem Uncirculated.

The Z/2 serial prefix identifies this as a replacement note, a specialist variety produced to replace faulty or withdrawn notes during the printing process. This type belongs to South Africa's first decimal banknote series following the introduction of the Rand in 1961, with the One Rand denomination replacing the former 10 Shillings value.

High-grade replacement notes from this early Republic period are particularly attractive to collectors of South African paper money, decimal transition issues, and PMG-certified replacement notes. A specialist ND(1992) South African blank Fifty Rand banknote paper associated with the C.L. Stals signature type and bearing the lion watermark used for the Fifty Rand issue.

This item relates to the 1992-1999 Big Five banknote series, in which the issued Fifty Rand note features lions on the face and the Sasol oil refinery with atomic symbols on the reverse. As a blank note or production-related piece, it should be treated as a specialist paper money item rather than a standard issued circulation banknote.

It offers appeal to collectors of South African Reserve Bank notes, banknote errors, printing-stage material, and Big Five series varieties. The obverse features the portrait of Paul Kruger, while the reverse carries Coert L. Steynberg's springbok design, one of the most recognisable motifs in South African numismatics.

With its Prooflike designation, first-year status and recognised Van Der Spuy provenance, this example offers strong appeal to collectors of South African gold, Krugerrands, certified bullion coinage, and important modern South African numismatic types. 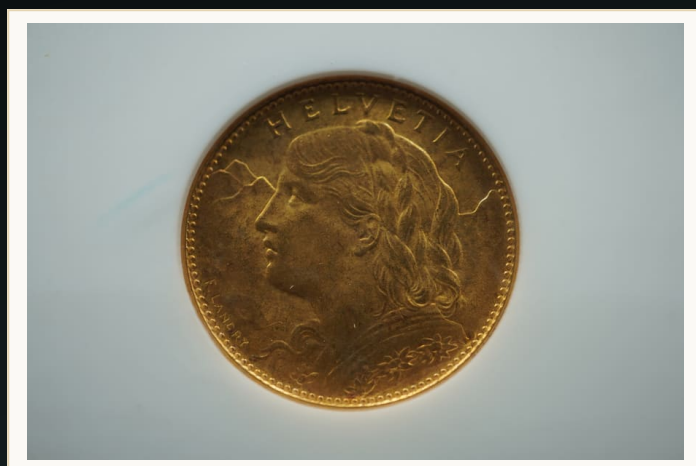

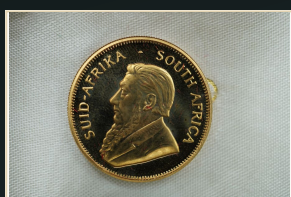
