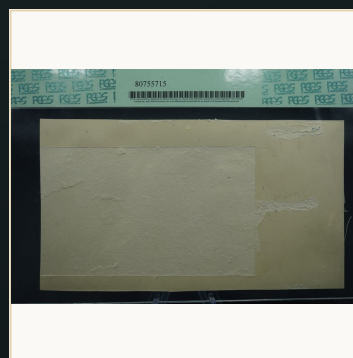

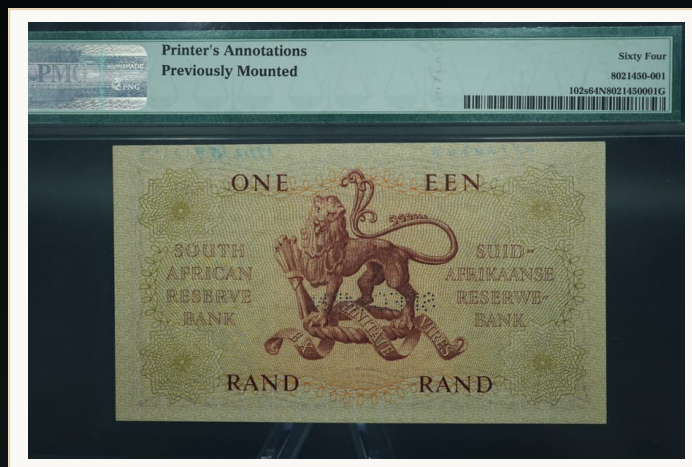

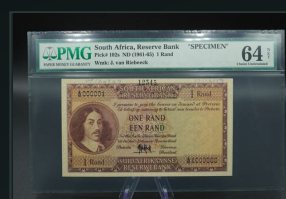

The Veld Pond was produced in 1902 during the final phase of the Anglo-Boer War under field conditions. Its emergency manufacture and hand-finished appearance distinguish it sharply from regular Pretoria Mint coinage.

The NGC holder records the important qualification UNC Details Tooled, which must be considered when assessing the coin. Despite the surface qualification, the type remains one of the most historically evocative gold issues of the ZAR.
